To whom it may concern:

I am writing to endorse the apostolate Road to Purity and its founder, Mr. Dann Aungst, a Catholic who lives in the Archdiocese of Denver. Dann founded the Road to Purity in 2015 after experiencing a profound conversion and realizing that he was a sex addict.

Through Road to Purity, Dann produces books, pamphlets and small group resources to help men and women recover their true identity as sons and daughters of the Father and break free from addiction to pornography and sex. Three of his publications bear my own *Imprimatur*. In addition to working with lay people, Dann has also given talks to seminarians and deacons at St. John Vianney Theological Seminary to help them understand how to effectively hear Confessions about sexual sins. Dann is also leading several groups of seminarians through his integrity program entitled *Restoring God's Foundation*.
